

## Policy for Senior Students

1	Students arrive <b>at school on time and attend roll call each day.</b>	Students must attend roll call each day.	Students have Senior Roll Call groups where senior issues are discussed.	Late students will make up missed time in their own time.
2	Students <b>arrive promptly to class.</b>	Students arrive promptly to class.	Students maximise their learning time.	Late students will make up missed time and missed work in their own time.
3	Students <b>use study periods for study.</b>	Students attend the designated study area and work quietly.	Students maximise their learning time.	Attendance cards to monitor student attendance at all classes.
4	Students leave school after their last period of the day to <b>go home and study.</b>	Students sign out and leave school promptly to study.	Flexible finishing times when there are no scheduled classes.	Students must remain until the end of the school day.
5	Students <b>remain at school</b> during recess and lunch and attend all scheduled classes.	Students remain at school and use the school facilities.	Use of seniors only area(s)	Attendance cards, make-up lessons, detentions. Students found in local shops may be regarded as breaching school and DET rules for continuing disobedience which may result in suspension from school.
6	Students <b>drive safely</b> to and from school and in the school grounds.	Students provide a completed form granting permission drive safely to and from school and in school grounds, with the names of any passengers noted.	Parking in school grounds. Bringing a car to school.	Loss of parking privileges. Loss of permission to drive a car to school.
7	Once at school, all student purchases of food and beverages will be at the <b>school canteen.</b>	Purchases should be made at recess and lunch.	Purchases during study periods are possible in view of extended school days due to TAFE, VET and extension courses.	Students leaving the school grounds without permission from Principal or Deputy Principal will face the consequences listed in 5 above.
8	Students to wear Senior Uniform	Purchase and wear: Navy skirt, tailored shorts or pants (no short shorts or track pants) White shirt with a collar (Polo shirt OK) Navy jumper, cardigan or Senior Jersey Black enclosed leather shoes	The distinction of having a special senior uniform. Uniform rewards given to roll class with the best uniform record.	Uniform detention leading to normal consequences for non compliance.
9	Follow Assessment Policy	Read and become familiar with the Assessment Booklet and follow the policy.	Every student is given an Assessment Booklet.	Normal notification of non completion of tasks leading to risk of no HSC.
