

Richmond High School Awards System

Pictured below are our new Awards Certificates. Awards have been simplified across the entire school with a consistent style applied overall, resulting in professional looking Certificates for student resumes.

A flow chart is outlined on the following page and it explains how the new Award System works. Parents of students receiving Principal's, Bronze, Silver or Gold Awards will be invited to a formal Recognition Assembly which will be held here at our school during Week 10 of each term.

Students who have earned one or more Gold Awards may be eligible to receive the prestigious Richmond Medal awarded at Presentation Night in December of each year.
