The incursion is aimed to provide students the opportunity to complete the **WHITE CARD COURSE (Construction Induction) - CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the Construction Industry**. This course will be held at **Richmond High School** in the **TRADE TRAINING CENTRE**. The White Card is a **mandatory component** for students studying VET Subjects Construction and Entertainment.

This course offers the general WHS induction information students require to work on a construction site in Australia and is led by REGISTERED TRAINING ORGANISATION (RTO) 91583 **FORKTIME**. This is a Face-face Induction Course as required by Safework NSW.

The cost of the incursion is: **\$100**. This is payable to the **Finance Office** or through the **School App**.

The incursion will occur during the whole day (8:35am-2:45pm) in the **TRADE TRAINING CENTRE**.

Important information

In the event of injury, no personal injury insurance cover is provided by the NSW Department of Education for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity.
